For whom

Adult education training intended specifically for immigrants

- who are over the age of 17
- who can read and write, but whose Finnish language skills are still quite limited.

Objectives and content

The aim of the training is to learn the Finnish language in preparation for continued studies or working life, and to receive information and skills that are necessary to take care of daily matters and manage within Finnish society.

Study areas include:

- Finnish language and communications skills (e.g., Finnish as a second language (S2) and information and communications technology courses)
- Working life and social skills (e.g., working life knowledge, knowledge of the culture and country, basic social services)
- Study guidance (includes, among other things, study and communication skills, training for job seeking, further plans)

Adult education studies

- The studies take place in groups of 15–20 students.
- The studies are full-time for a total of 25 hours per week.

Application process

Apply using the electronic application form no later than 15 December 2020.

Fees

The total fee for the training is €175/month (lunches on training days included).

Ask about the possibilities to receive support for your studies from, for example, Kela or TE services. If it is possible, through the TE office, to have the training included as part of your integration plan, the training will be free of charge for you.

In earlier years, it has been possible for the Church Training College to provide aid to cover the monthly fees for some students through study voucher grants issued by the Finnish National Board of Education.
